Education

The mission of the Lake Travis ISD is to educate all students by teaching a comprehensive curriculum which emphasizes scholastic excellence. Our graduates will have lifelong problem-solving skills and will understand that responsibilities accompany the privileges of citizenship and will have the foundation to be successful in their chosen endeavors.

The Lake Travis Independent School District serves the growing area of Lake Travis. Originally a component of the Dripping Springs ISD, Lake Travis ISD was formed on June 12, 1981. At that time, 541 students were enrolled in grades K - 12. Since then, the District enrollment has increased to more than 6,100 students in nine campuses. The District has five elementary schools, two middle schools, one high school and an alternative school. Lake Travis ISD is currently rated Academically Acceptable.

Recreation

Lake Travis is a recreational paradise with boating, camping, fishing, hunting, tennis, and golf being the primary activities enjoyed by residents and tourists alike.

Lakeway has numerous parks. City Park provides 64 acres of beautifully maintained parklands for the residents of Lakeway and their guests. The park can be reached by water from Hurst Creek Cove on Lake Travis. There are many things to do at City Park. With nearly two miles of trails, there is plenty of room for everyone from leisurely walkers to vigorous joggers and kids on bicycles or roller blades. For those who want to enjoy the park at a slower pace, the Butterfly Garden is a perfect place to spend the afternoon. The Canyonlands is the City of Lakeway's newest park. The Canyonlands is a 20 acre tract named for the scenic canyon running through the property. This canyon is the upper reaches of the Rough Hollow Cove, a major arm of Lake Travis. The scenery of the canyon from the overlooks is breathtaking.

The Lakeway Activity Center is a multi-use facility owned and operated by the City for the purpose of conducting, promoting, and facilitating outstanding social, civic and recreational activities. The Activity Center offers many activities for all ages. In addition, Lakeway also has a Swim Center. Located in the Heart of Lakeway, the center amenities include: a skate park, basketball and volleyball equipment, concession areas, restrooms/showers, climbing wall, canyonlands hiking, terraced-sunning area, large pool slides and several picnic areas.
